The Provincial Unsolved Homicide Unit has been involved in the investigation of the homicide of two 13 year old boys in Stanley Park, Vancouver, B.C.

The boys were originally reported missing from Burnaby, B.C. in December 1989, and the skull of one of the victims was found in Stanley Park in July 1990.

Eventually the skull of the other boy was also discovered.

As both skulls were found within a relatively close geographic area, a concentrated search was organized in an attempt to locate the remainder of the victims bones.

Ms. C. Dornan and several of her associates involved in Northwest Bloodhounds volunteered their services and provided the investigators with additional areas to be examined. The enthusiasm and professionalism displayed by Northwest Bloodhounds was greatly appreciated.
